



17th International Sculpture Symposium in St Blasien, 2012

Central idea of this Symposium is

“In the beginning there was Goodness:...”

Quotation from Theodor Däubler, Expressionism (1916)

Theodor Däubler (born 17th. August, 1876 in Trieste, Austria-Hungary, died 13th June, 1934 in St Blasien, in the Black Forest) was a German writer, epicist, poet, narrator and arthistorian.

The 17th sculpture symposium will be organised both by the town council of St. Blasien and the local publicity and advertising circle. It will take place from **26th August until 2nd September, 2012**. 15 artists of different nationalities, chosen by a jury of experts, will be invited. The closing date for applications is **31st March, 2012**. The jury will announce the names of the successful applicants on **17th April 2012, at 10 am**.

The work stations are to be found under canopies at chosen spots in the centre of St. Blasien. You will receive a tree trunk (spruce/Douglas fir/maple) of between 180 cm and 240 cm in height and with a circumference of 50 to 60 cm. Upon request, the trunks can be sawn beforehand (2 halves or planks of specified dimensions). All tools and extra materials must be provided by the sculptors themselves, but for those artists travelling by bus, train or plane, chain saws will be available. A contract of work will be made with each artist. A copy of the contract is available in mid-February on the internet.

Each artist receives a pre-tax fee of €1000, which will be paid on completion of the sculpture. In addition, a lump-sum for travel expenses will be provided. The lodge in the Hotel Kehr wieder (www.hotel-kehrwieder.de) will be borne by the organiser. In addition, participants will receive the event period, a lunch and a dinner.

The sculptures become the property of the organiser and will be auctioned on Sunday, 2nd September on the square in front of the "Dom" church. A prize of a further 1.000 € will be presented to the artist whose work is chosen by the public.

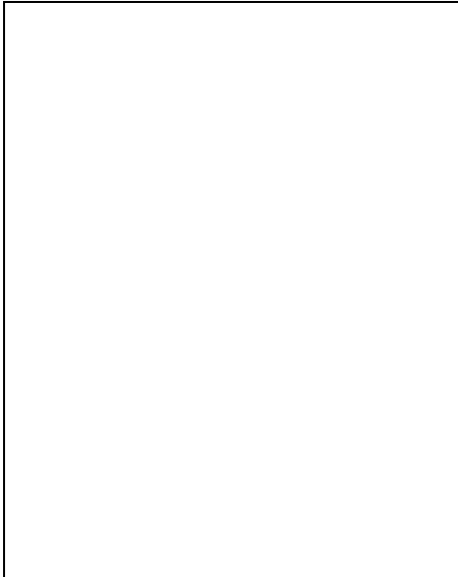
